### ALICE'S ADVENTURES IN WONDERLAND

## **PRE- READING ACTIVITY**

#### Level B1 Low Intermediate

#### Time 10 minutes

Aim: to create interest in the reading of the text

#### Learning outcomes:

- Students will be able to make predictions about the content of the text
- Students wil be able to write a paragraph based on their predictions

Competences targeted: communicative ( linguistic and discourse) in producing written and oral messages based on the reception of a written message

#### Main skill: reading

Integrated skills: writing and speaking

Interraction: T-S; S-T; S-S;

#### Preparation

T prepares a handout on the appropriate reading passage.

#### Procedure

**Step 1**. Teacher passes the handouts around asking the students to to read the title of the text and the first paragraph of the passage in order to form their predictions.

**Step 2**. T asks students to work in groups and write about what they think the passage will be about based on the information they got in step one. T reminds students that they will have to answer the "5 Wh questions" while writing their paragraphs: Who performs the action/ What happens? When does the action take place? / Where does the action take place? Why do the things happen? T writes the questions on the board.

Students perform the task while following the structure of the "5 Wh- questions" in their answers. ( pair work).

Step 3.T asks for volunteers to read their paragraphs to the whole class.

Students will compare predictions, voting for the most realistic/ most extravagant one. T tells students that they will be able to compare their predictions with the text, after reading the entire passage, during the next stage of the lesson.

Teacher's roles: prompter, facilitator, observer.

Students'roles: editor/spokesperson, reflector.
