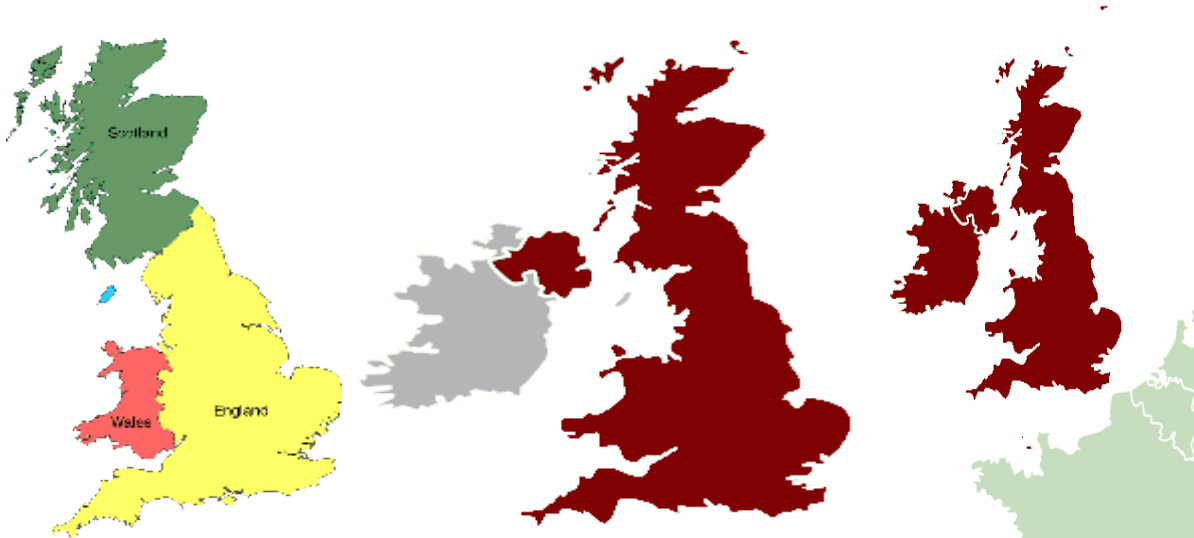


WHICH IS WHICH ?
